



ADVENTURE, HARD WORK AND TONS OF FUN

July 22 - July 26, 2019

Who: Students from Refinery Church entering 6th through 12th grade in Fall 2019. Graduating 2019 seniors can come, too!

What: A week packed with adventure, hard work and tons of fun! We'll arrive with a purpose in Atlanta: to serve the city, create memories, and have a blast together as we take steps to encounter and follow Jesus.

When: Monday, July 22 – Friday, July 26, 2019.

Important Dates:

Monday, July 8th: deadline to register online, pay and turn in paperwork.

Monday, July 22nd: arrive at The Refinery Church by 7:30am.

Friday, July 26th: we'll return to church around 9pm.

Where: We're staying at Harvest Community Church, 701 Cole Dr SW, Lilburn, GA 30047. There are separate rooms for guys and girls to sleep as well as separate showers and restrooms. We'll serve within the community and experience some of the cool attractions that Atlanta has to offer!

Cost: \$175, plus money for 3 fast food meals while on the road (lunch on the way down and lunch and dinner on the way back). Use the money you bring wisely! No loans between students!

Register and pay at refinerychurch.cc/events or use the Refinery Ohio app. Look for Atlanta Arrival 2019. If you'd prefer to pay with cash or check please register online and submit cash or check (made out to Refinery Church) to the office.

Student & Guardian Expectations: All trip materials must be completed and turned in by Monday, July 8th. This includes payment and a currently valid Civil & Medical Liability form. If you're unsure if you already have a valid one on file, just ask Ben! To stay connected with our friends on the trip, we will limit phone use to specified times. Students will respect adults and others. A guardian will be contacted to retrieve their student if a student displays continual disrespect, continual inappropriate behavior, intentional violence, or any behavior that is a threat to safety.

What to Bring: Make sure you can carry everything! 1 medium suitcase (or duffel bag), air mattress (optional) and 1 small bag for the road should be all you need.

- Bible and pen or pencil
- Sleeping bag (or sheets/blanket) & pillow
- Air mattress (optional). We'll sleep on the floor so a pad or air mattress is a good idea.
- At least 6 changes of clean clothes. We'll be working hard, so include some clothes that you're not afraid to get dirty.
- Modest swimsuit and towel. One piece for ladies – no speedos, dudes!
- Pajamas (favorite Teddy Bear optional)
- Bath towel, washrag, soap, toothpaste, toothbrush, deodorant, other toiletries
- Contact solution (if needed)
- An extra pair of shoes (may get dirty while working)
- Rain jacket
- Refillable water bottle
- Sunscreen & insect repellent
- Work gloves (leather gloves or heavy gardening gloves)
- Snacks for the road and to munch on throughout the week
- \$\$ for 3 fast food meals while on the road. \$20 should be plenty.
- Prescription medication in a zippered bag with dosage information included (Let Ben know if you're bringing this and we will assign an adult to help monitor).



Please Don't Bring: Anything dangerous, disrespectful, completely unnecessary, or incredibly distracting. Examples include tobacco products, alcohol, illegal drugs, legal (but unnecessary) drugs, lighters, matches, knives (including pocket knives), weapons, revealing clothing (dudes and ladies, both). If you're not sure whether to bring it or not, don't bring it.
